I hope my stories, workshops, and other works help many people in the years to come."

Packer began sharing stories as a child, inspired by her librarian mother and writer father. She obtained a degree with honors in Folklore and Mythology from Boston University and has been performing storyteller for over 25 years. Her 2019 books, *From Audience to Zeal: The ABCs of Finding, Crafting, and Telling a Great Story* and *From Audience to Zeal: The Workbook* won

best in their category from Storytelling World Awards. She has won many previous awards

including the 2018 Minnesota Grand Storytelling Slam, the Brother Blue Award from New

England Storytelling, and others.
